Subject :- Issue of promotion for X-Ray Attendant/
Laboratory Attendants in Medical Department.

Reference Board's letter of even number dated 3.9.1971 and your reply thereto. The Board have considered the matter and decided that 50% of the vacancies of Radiographer (X-Ray Technicians) in scale Rs.110-200(AS) and Laboratory Assistants in scale Rs.110-200(AS) should be filled by promotion of X-Ray Attendants and Laboratory Attendants respectively and the remaining 50% vacancies should be filled by direct recruitment as per conditions prescribed in their letter No. E(NG)65RC1/143 dated 9.8.1966. Posts thus open to promotion should be filled by a positive act of selection which should be confined only to those staff who possess the qualification of Matriculation with Physics & Chemistry; those of the staff in question who possess a Diploma in X-Ray Technicians/Laboratory Technician's Course from a recognised Institution, should have put in a minimum of three years, and the others a minimum of five years Railway Service to be eligible for promotion. If the requisite number of suitable staff are not found from amongst the eligible candidates as a result of the selection so conducted to fill 50% of the vacancies set apart for promotion, the vacancies left unfilled will not be carried forward and may be filled by direct recruitment.
