In terms of orders contained in Board's letter No. E(NG)I-65RC1/143 dated 11.10.1966 addressed to the General Manager, Northern Railway, capy endorsed to you, it was laid down that serving employees who are Matriculates with Physics and Chemistry as subjects and have put in a minimum of 15 years service, may be considered for appointment to posts of X-Ray(Technicians) in scale Rs. 150-300 (AS). According to Board's letter No. E(NG)I-70 M1/229 dated 8.9.1971, those staff in the Medical Department who possess the requisite qualifications prescribed for direct recruit-ment to posts of X-Ray Technicians (Rs. 150-300) should be considered for promotion by a duly constituted Selection Board in accordance with the prescribed procedure.

- The Board have now decided that the staff who do not possess a Diploma in Radiography, as prescribed for direct recruitment, should also be considered for selection to post of Radiographer in scale Rs. 150-300 (AS) previded they have completed 10 years service as Radiographer Grade II (Rs.110-200 (AS).
- The Board, have also decided that ad hoc arrangements may be made on temporary basis against short term / leave vacancies in the category of Radiographer (Rs. 150-300) by promotion from amongst Radiographer Gr. II (Rs. 110-200) according to seniority-cum-suitability; possession of the requisite professional qualifications need not be insisted upon for this purpose.
