> Sub: Filling up of the post of Laboratory Superintendent in the Grade Rs.550-900(RS) - Relaxation of educational qualifications and experience.

In terms of Ministry of Railways letter No.E(NG)III-72RC1/16 dated 1.8.72, the following qualifications have been laid down for direct recruitment of Laboratory Superintendents in the scale of Rs.550-900(RS):

"M.Sc. (Chemistry preferably Biochemistry and/ or Organic Chemistry) with experience of two years in a Laboratory or Institution undertaking analysis connected with Food drugs or chemical Biochemistry."

"B.Sc.Chemistry with 5 years experience in analysis of Food, water, drugs or Chemical Biochemistry."

- 2. For departmental promotion also, qualification laid down for chemists in the scale of Rs.425-700 for promotion as laboratory Superintendent is graduaction in science with five years experience as Chemist.
- 3. As difficulties were experienced in getting suitably qualified persons by way of educational qualifications and experience as laid down above, it has been decided by the Ministry of Railways that for filling up the upgraded post of Iaboratory Superintendent in the scale of Rs.550-900(RS), the qualification of graducation in science should not be insisted upon. Similarly the requirement of 5 years service should also be dispensed with as one-time dispensation in this category to the available persons of 4 years' standing. Accordingly seniormost employees available in the next lower grade may be considered for promotion to the above posts.
