Subject: Relaxation of educational qualification for promotion to the post of Laboratory Assistants/X-Ray Technicians (Radiographer) in scale Rs. 260-400(RS).

Ministry of Railways had been considering the question of relaxation of educational qualifications for promotion to the post of Laboratory Assistants/ X-Ray Technicians (Radiographer) in the scale of Rs. 260-400(RS). In this connection comments/views production of the various railway administrations/ units were also called for. After considering all the pros and cons of the matter as well as the comments received from the Railways, Ministry of Railways have decided that no general relaxation in the educational qualifications may be granted in this respect as that would lead to dilution of standards in manning these posts. Individual cases of relaxation on merits may, however, be referred to them for consideration. While processing the individual cases of relaxation, it may please be ensured that the persons promoted under relaxed qualifications should not be further promoted as persons so promoted may not be fit for working as Radiographer Gr. I, scale Rs. 330-560/Asstt. Chemist scale Rs, 380-560, the next avenue of promotion for this category of staff.
