Reference your letter No.HPB/785/R/BD/Steno dated 26.9.85 on the above subject a photo copy of which was received with Sh. P.P. Srivastava, the then Addl. C.P.O.'s D.O. letter dated 15.7.86.

2. It is seen that Board's confirmation has been asked for to the post of Stenographers in scale Rs.650-960 attached to the General Manager being treated as Cadre post in the light of the instructions existing before the upgradation ordered in this Ministry's letter No.PC-III-84-UPG/16 dated 2.2.85 and with the objective of fixing the pay of the incumbents on their promotion to Group 'B' post of A.P.O. with reference to pay drawn in grade Rs.650-960. In this connection your attention is invited to stipulations contained in para 3 of this Ministry's letter No.E(EF) 74/2/20 Pt.I dated 20.9.84 in terms of which if the post of CA to General Manager in grade Rs.650-960 is filled on the basis of seniority subject to fitness from amongst the Stenographers in scale Rs.550-900 the employee should be treated as having been appointed on a regular basis to the grade Rs.650-960 and he will rank senior to employees working in grade Rs.700-900. On the analogy of these instructions and subject to fulfilment of conditions stipulated therein there is no objection to pay of the staff concerned being fixed on promotion to Group 'B' post of A.P.O. with reference to pay drawn by them in scale Rs.650-960(RS).

3. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
