Rs.4000-6000 against DP quota in CKP division.**

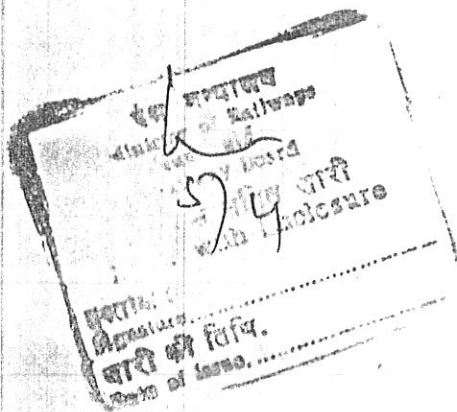

Reference S. E. Railway's letter No.P/H-7/STN dt.15.03.2005 on the above subject.

2. The Railway's reference which has been received after seven months of issue of Board's letter of 17.8.2004 makes no mention of availability of Stenographers from RRB under DR quota the panel of which was expected in December, 2004. Nonetheless it is advised that the issue of considering shorthand knowing Gr. 'D' staff for appearing in the selection for promotion to the post of Stenographer Gr.- III was considered by the Board earlier but not agreed to. Group 'D' staff fulfilling the qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment are eligible to appear in the GDCE which the S. E. Railway must be implementing since DR quota in the category is more than 25% and, shortfall, against promotion quota is also required to be added to the direct recruitment quota.

3. S. E. Railway must also be aware that besides Shorthand knowing Clerks, Shorthand knowing Typists have also been made eligible to appear in the selection against 25% promotion quota vide Board's letter No.E(NG)I/98/RR-1/14 dt.16.03.1999.- F/B
