**Sub:-Introduction of 20% LDCE quota in the categories of OS-II scale
Rs.5500-9000 and Welfare Inspectors in scale Rs.6500-10500.**

S.No.3!(PIC)

I am directed to refer to your letter No.AIRF/364(V CPC)(238) dt.09.05.2006 on the above subject and to state that as already advised to the Federation vide this Ministry's letter of even number dt.30.03.2006 that in order to provide relief to senior employees the instructions were issued vide Board's letter dt.20.02.2006 stipulating that till the prescribed percentages are reached the vacancies arising in the categories of OS-II and PI may be filled by LDCE and promotion by Selection on 50:50 basis. The Federation would no doubt be aware that the operation of post based rosters had become obligatory due to the Supreme Court's directions for change over from vacancy based rosters to post based rosters which was not the case in 1980-81 when direct recruitment etc. was introduced in the category of Sr. Clerks. Therefore, the situation being different now to what was prevalent in the year 1980-81, any further deviation from the existing procedure would not be advisable.
