Sub: - Cadre Review and restructuring of Group 'C' cadres.

Arising out of a demand made by the Staff Side in the Departmental Council (Railways) of the Joint consultative Machinery, the Ministry of Railways have decided that following Group 'C' categories should be tructured as indicated in Annexure 'A' with effect from 1.1.1984:-

- i) Technical Supervisors in the Production Units, Open Line including Open Line workshops of the Civil, Mechanical, Electrical and Signal & Telecommunication Departments.
- ii) Scientific staff of the CMT under the Mechanical Engineering Department.
- For the purpose of restructuring, the cadre trength as on 1.1.1984 will be taken into account and linelude Rest Giver and Leave Reserve Posts.
- Staff selected and posted against the additional higher grade posts as a result of restructuring will have their pay fixed under Rule 2018-B(FR-22C)RII with effect rom 1.1.1984. The benefit of fixation effective from 1.1.984 will also be applicable to the chain/resultant resultant cancies. In effect, the benefit of fixation from 1.1.984 should be given against all vacamies which rise from restructuring.
- The existing classification of the posts covered by these restructuring orders, as "Selection" and "Non-Selection" as the case may be, remains unchanged. However, for the purpose of implementation of these orders, if an individual railway servant becomes due for promotion to individual railway servant basis, and such hagher grade post is classified as a "Selection" post, the existing selection procedure will stand modified in such a case to the extent that the selection will be based only on scrutiny of service records without holding any written service viva voce test. Naturally, under this procedure, the extegorisation as 'Outstanding' will not exist.

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4.2 In case, however, as a result of these restriction orders, an individual railway servant becomes due for promotion to a grade more than one grade above that the post held by him at present on a regular basis, the benefit of the modified procedure of selection as aformable be applicable only to the first such promotion that post happens to be a 'Selection' post, the second and subsequent promotions, if any, will be based only on the mormal rules relating to filling in of 'Selection' posts (as the case may be).

4.3 Vacancies existing on 1.1.1984 and those arising on that date from this cadre restructuring should be filled in the following sequence:—

- i) from panels approved on or before 30.4.1984 and current on that date; and
 - ii) balance in the manner indicated in parcs 4.1 and 4.2 above.

5.1 The extant orders regarding recruitment of Engineering Graduates to grade Rs.550-750 will stand modified in that:-

- •1 20% of vacancies arising after 1.1.1984 in grade Rs.700-900 in the category of teams supervisors of all Departments will be filled by direct recruitment of Engineering Graduan through Railway Service Commissions.
- .2 There will be no direct recruitment in future in the grade of Rs.550-750, except that where a panel of candidates for direct recruitment in this grade has already been received by Railway Administration from the Railway Sarvas Commissions, appointments therefrom (subject usual formalities) will be made to the grade Rs.550-750.

5.2 Specific qualifications prescribed for Installations for recruitment currently to grade Rs. 550 now automatically apply to grade Rs. 700-900.

There is currently provision for direct in the category of Chemists and Metallurgist Assistant in grade Rs.425-700 to the extent of 33-1/3%. Common to restructuring the percentage of direct recruitment grade Rs.425-700 will be raised to 66-2/3%. The qualitations prescribed will remain unchanged. This will be effective for vacancies arising after 1.1.1984.

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The existing rules and orders in regard to reservation for SC/ST will continue to apply while filling up additional vacancies in the higher grades arising as a

The Non-functional selection grade posts created in the categories covered by these orders should be adjusted against the upgraded posts. Any holders of non-functional selection grades not so adjusted will continue to retain such grades as personal to them till the next review. Details of such cases should be reported to the Board by

In all the categories covered by this letter even though posts in higher scales of pay have been introduced as a result of restructuring, the basic function, duties and responsibilities, attached to these posts at present ill continue to which may be added such other duties and responsibilities as considered appropriate.

The Board desire that restructuring and posting staff after due process of selection should be completed

The Railways will carefully assess requirement of ands on account of this restructuring for the year 1984-85 include them in the Revised Estimates for 1984-85.
