Caspter III.

Para 10. - Mutual exchange:-

Substitute the following for this Paragraph:-

Reilway servents transferred on mutual exchange from one cadre of a division, office or Railway to the corresponding cadre in another division, office of railway shall retain their seniority on the basis of their promotion to the grade, or take the seniority of the railway servants with whom they have exchanged, whichever of the two may be lower.
