transferred to the Clerical cadre  
of the Accounts Department.

The matter has been reviewed in the light of information received from the Railways and it has been decided that (i) Stenographers/Typists in scale Rs.130-300(AS) permanent/directly recruited, being in the higher grade, should for all purposes be considered senior and should get promotion/posting as Clerk Grade I in scale Rs.130-300(AS) first and

(ii) Stenographers/Typists officiating in scale Rs.130-300(AS) and Rs.110-180(AS) should first be interpolated with Clerks Grade II in scale Rs.110-180(AS) on the basis of length of service in grade Rs.110-180(AS) and then promotions/postings as Clerk Grade I in scale Rs.130-300(AS) ordered accordingly.

In both the above cases, the inter-se seniority should not be disturbed.

2. It is also clarified that instructions contained in Board's letter No.E(S)62-CPC/59 dated 4-8-1962 do not apply to the staff in the Accounts Department.
