
Sub: Fixation of seniority of staff in RITES and
IRCON.

Reference correspondence resting with Shri G.S.
Thirumalai, Chief Manager (Pers. & Admn.), RITES'
D.O. letter No.PERS/84/34 dt. 11/12/85 on the above
subject.

2. The matter has been reviewed in the light of
representations received by this Department. The
Department of Railways have now decided that the guidelines
contained in Para 1(iii) of their letter of even number
dt. 20/6/84 may be substituted with the following:

"For those who were drafted in RITES/IRCON from
the Indian Railways before the 'appointed day', relative
seniority in RITES/IRCON will be regulated in such a
manner that due weightage is given to their relative
position on the Railways such that a person is not treated
as junior to another merely by reason of the fact that
he joined RITES/IRCON later. RITES/IRCON should draw
up appropriate guidelines, inter-alia, with this objective
in view and notify the same for the information of all
the employees concerned".
