Sub : Transfers in the event of winding up of
establishment - consultation with organised
labour.

In the PNM meeting held between the National Federation and the Railway Board on 21/22.2.1977 the General Secretary of the Federation desired that when an establishment is wound up or discontinued and staff are transferred en masse in order to alleviate staff distress, the issue should be discussed with recognised labour. He mentioned the case of Raiguda on S.E. Railway and 2 or 3 sheds on the W. Rly where unilateral action had been taken. The Board (Member, Staff) agreed that when there is any closure of activity in any particular station, the Railway concerned should take into confidence its labour. This would assist in proper arrangements being made to deal with human problems that might arise in such cases.

The Board desire that whenever there is a proposal to close a particular establishment, the above procedure should be followed.
