Vide letter under reference, basically following two clarifications have been sought for:

- (i) What would the term "equivalent" mean used in Para (v) of Board's letter issued vide RBE No. 130/2010 as the Army uses several types of certificates which is equated to various educational standards in civil societies; and
- (ii) Whether ex-servicemen who has put in less than 15 years of service and has got an initial matriculate certificate without Army class -I certificates can also be considered.

2. As regards (i) above, it is apprised that candidates in possession of Army class I certificates (Hindi) may be considered as equivalent with that of Army class II English certificate in light of letter of Department of Ex-servicemen Welfare 34162/2010/C2 dated 03.12.2010 cited in letter ibid.

3. As regard (ii) above, it is informed that Board's letter issued under RBE 130/2010 clearly stipulates that ex-servicemen who have retired after putting in 15 years of service and has passed Army Class-I certificates or equivalent will be considered while recruiting such people. Therefore, clarification sought in (ii) above does not hold good.

I invite a kind reference to the letter cited.

In order to clarify the eligibility criteria, which was stipulated by Railway Board (Ministry of Railways) vide their letter No.2009/E(NG)-II/RR-1/10 dated 10.9.2010 for the above recruitment that " Ex-Servicemen who has retired after putting in 15 years of service and has passed Army Class – I Certificate or equivalent will be considered eligible" , it is informed that the following Military qualifications are equivalence to civil qualifications as shown against each as per the letter No.F.22/2/60-B-3 dated 19.6.1960 from the Secretary, Ministry of Education Government of India

It is also informed that the "Indian Army Special Certificate of Education" equivalent to civil Matriculation as per the Authority of Department of Education Health and Lands No.GF 32/4/43-E dated 9.4.1943.

As per the above orders it is clarified that the Indian Army II Class English Certificate is equivalent to the Army Class I Certificate of Education (Hindi). Despite the above orders being kept effective with effect from the late 80s, the minimum Education Qualification for recruitment in the Armed forces is Matriculation except for the Tradesman categories like cook, tailor, EBR, barber, washerman for which minimum Education Qualification is 5th Std. Further I am to inform that those who have been enrolled in the armed forces with Non Matric. and discharged with pension after completing 15 years of service will be treated as equivalent to "Matriculate" and those who have been enrolled with Matriculation and discharged with pension after completing 15 years of service will be treated as equivalent to "Graduate"

Whenever the applications are invited from the Ex.servicemen to fill up the reserved vacancies representative of the Rajya Sainik Board / Directorate of Ex.servicemen's Welfare are included in the screening / selection Committee.

Hence you are at liberty to refer back to us during scrutiny / selection process.
