Sub: Reservation of SC/STs on ex cadre posts
filled up on tenure basis.

Kindly refer to the correspondence resting with
RDSO's letter No.E-I/7/ART/120 dated 10.12.96 on the
above cited subject.

2. The matter has been examined in detail with
reference of the relevant recruitment rules and found
that in all the 18 categories the posts are filled up
by holding the selections restricted to the RDSO staff
or the staff of Zonal Railways. Their normal tenure of
5 years which is curtailable/extendable. The selected
candidates assume the higher responsibilities in the
higher grade. It is found that these posts are not
deputation or transfer posts, therefore, reservation
rules are applicable and the same have to be extended
immediately. It is further clarified that if tenure
posts are filled up by mode of promotion either from
the RDSO staff or the staff of Zonal Railways/Production
Units, the reservation rules have to be adhered to
strictly. Position may be reviewed for similar posts
which are kept outside the reservation rules and extend
the application of reservation rules in similar cases.
Action taken report may be submitted.
