There have been persistent demands in the JCM(DC) and other forums for enhancement of the annual per capita contribution to Staff Benefit Fund to meet the increasing needs and requirements in certain sphere of activities financed by the Staff Benefit Fund. These demands have been under consideration of the Ministry of Railways for quite some time and it has now been decided that the existing per capita contribution of Rs.20 may be raised to Rs.25 with effect from the financial year 1996-97. Consequently the distribution of the amount amongst the various activities to be financed by the Staff Benefit Fund has been revised as under:-
