Sub: Fixation of pay of officers on ad hoc promotion to Level-I and Level-II posts on the Rlys. for looking after the duties of the higher posts.

Doubts have been expressed about the manner in which the ad hoc officiating pay of officers who are promoted from J.A. Grade/ADRM to Level-II posts and from Level-II to Level-I on an ad hoc basis, to look after the duties of the higher posts ahead of their turn for officiating promotion on a regular basis, should be fixed in the context of admissibility of ad hoc ADA in terms of instructions contained in Board's letter No. PCIII/82/DA/1 dated 26.3.82.

2. Officers promoted to these higher posts on an ad hoc basis before they are due for regular promotion are allowed officiating pay which is restricted under Rule 2029 (FR-35)-R.II. However, since the posting orders which were being issued from time to time in such cases had indicated the total officiating pay in terms of basic pay in the lower post plus what was being referred to as special pay, there have been occasions to question the admissibility of ad hoc ADA on the total officiating pay after such ad hoc promotions.


3. In order to eliminate doubts in the matter and to correctly apply the provisions contained in the Fundamental Rules, the Board have decided that with effect from 1.1.82 the ad hoc officiating pay of officers on promotion from J.A. Grade/ADRM to Level-II (Rs.2250-2500/-) and from Level-II to Level-I (Rs.2500-2750/-) should be regulated in terms of table of fixation of pay, which is enclosed to this letter.

4. In so far as promotions from ADRM to Level-II are concerned, the fixation of ad hoc officiating pay will have to be made with reference to the basic pay in the J.A. Grade post (Rs.1500-2000/-) and not with reference to the scale of ADRM (Rs.2000-2250/-).

5. Officiating pay in all these cases may be refixed accordingly with effect from 1.1.82 and for all future promotions to these posts on ad hoc basis fixation of pay may be made as in the enclosed table.

6. The above issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.


