

NOTES :-

1. Position is as on 01/01/05 except for Members, Railway Board, Additional Members, Railway Board and Officers attached to Minister of Railways & Minister of State for Railways whose position has been further updated upto 01-03-2005. Position regarding General Managers/equivalent and Secy./R.B. is also as on 01-03-2005.
 2. **Nothing in this list is to be taken as conveying any sanction or authority, or should be held to supersede any standing rule or any order of the Government of India with which it may be at variance.**
 3. The position of an officer in this List does not necessarily show his seniority.
 4. The date of appointment to service is :-
 - (a) For Direct Recruit officers/S.C.R.A.s, the date of joining the service as Probationers;
 - (b) For officers who have been promoted from Lower Service, the date of regular appointment to the Higher Service
 - (c) For Group 'C' employees officiating in Group 'B' the date of appointment in Group 'C';
 - (d) For officers initially recruited as Temporary Officers, but later absorbed in Group 'A' Junior Scale, the date of appointment as Temporary Officers.
 5. The date for increment on time scale of the officers in Group 'A' Service is :-
 - (a) For officers appointed direct to the Junior Scale of a Group 'A' Service, the date of joining service in Junior Scale;
 - (b) For officers taken over from ex-State Railways, the "declared dates" allotted to them;
 - (c) For other officers i.e. War Service Candidates, officers appointed direct to the Senior Scale by special recruitment, Temporary Officers offered permanent appointments and officers promoted from lower grades, the date specifically determined for them as the date from which they will count seniority.
 6. The date of appointment to Grade appearing in HODs list is the date of appointment to S.A. Grade.
 7. 'Looking after' is with regard to arrangement made pending posting of regular incumbent.
 8. The department of which officers working in 'General/Other posts' belong, is indicated in the Remarks column.
 9. Pay indicated against incumbents is in the Railway Servants Revised Pay Scales (Fifth Pay Commission). Errors or omissions, if any, may be reported to the Joint Secretary (Gaz.), Railway Board, New Delhi, through proper channel.
