2. It is clarified that one set of post-retirement passes should be disallowed for every month on unauthorised retention of railway quarters by retired officers/staff. The concerned retired officers/staff may be allowed the privilege of post-retirement passes after the period during which the forfeited passes would have been admissible is over. For example, if a retired officer/employee retains railway quarters unauthorisedly for six months, six sets of post-retirement passes should be disallowed. He/she will be eligible for post-retirement passes after expiry of 6, 3 or 2 years, as the case may be, depending upon his/her entitlement for post-retirement passes in a year.

3. For the purpose of determining the number of passes to be disallowed, unauthorised retention for a part of a month exceeding 10 days in any calendar month should be taken as a full month.
