Subject: Grant of ex-gratia payment to unmarried daughters of SRPF(C) beneficiaries who had retired from service/died in service prior to 01.01.1986.

Consequent upon circulation of Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare (DOP&PW)'s O.M. No.1/19/03-P&PW(E) dated 6th September, 2007 on the Railways vide this office letter No. F(E)III/2007/PN1/5 dated 18.9.2007, extending the scope of family pension to unmarried daughters of Railway servants/pensioners even after attaining the age of 25 years at par with the widowed/divorced daughters, references have been received seeking clarification as to whether the benefit of the said instructions is also admissible to the unmarried daughters of SRPF(Contributory) retirees for the purpose of grant of ex-gratia payment.

2. The matter has been examined in consultation with DOP&PW and it is clarified that the provisions contained in this office letter dated 18.9.2007 referred to above are NOT applicable to the unmarried daughters of SRPF(C) beneficiaries, who had retired from service/died in service prior to 1.1.86, for the purpose of grant of ex-gratia beyond the age of 25 years.



पेंशन एवं पेंशनर्स कल्याण विभाग के 6 सितंबर, 2007 के कार्यालय ज्ञापन सं. 1/19/03-पी एंड पी डब्ल्यू (ई) को इस मंत्रालय के 18.09.2007 के पत्र सं. एफ(ई)III/2007/पीएन1/5, जिसमें रेल सेवकों/पेंशनर्स की अविवाहित पुत्रियों को विधवा/तलाकशुदा पुत्रियों की तरह ही 25 वर्ष की आयु प्राप्त कर लेने के बाद भी परिवार पेंशन देने के क्षेत्र को बढ़ाया गया है, को रेलों पर परिपत्रित करने के परिणामस्वरूप, संदर्भ प्राप्त हुए हैं जिनमें यह स्पष्टीकरण मांगा गया है कि क्या अनुग्रह राशि प्रदान करने के प्रयोजन हेतु उक्त अनुदेशों का लाभ एसआरपीएफ (अंशदायी) सेवानिवृत्तों की अविवाहित पुत्रियों को भी ग्राह्य है।

2. इस मामले की पेंशन एवं पेंशनभोगी कल्याण विभाग के परामर्श से जांच की गई है और यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि इस कार्यालय के 18.09.2007 के उपर्युक्त संदर्भाधीन पत्र में अंतर्विष्ट प्रावधान एसआरपीएफ (अंशदायी) लाभार्थियों, जो 01.01.1986 से पूर्व सेवा से सेवानिवृत्त हो गए थे या जिनका सेवा के दौरान निधन हो गया था, की अविवाहित पुत्रियों को 25 वर्ष की आयु प्राप्त करने के बाद अनुग्रह राशि प्रदान करने हेतु लागू नहीं हैं।



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Ex-gratia payment to the unmarried daughters of CPF beneficiaries who had retired from service prior to 1.1.86 – regarding.

The undersigned is to refer to the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board)'s O.M. No.F(E)III/2003/PN1/Ex.Gr./9. dt. 11.5.2009 on the above noted subject and to state that the provisions of this Department's O.M. No.1/19/03-P&PW(E) dt. 6.9.07, concerning extension of scope of family pension to unmarried daughters of Central Government servants/Pensioners, beyond the age of 25 years, are not applicable to the unmarried daughters of CPF beneficiaries for the purpose of grant of ex-gratia beyond the age of 25 years. Accordingly, the unmarried daughters of CPF beneficiaries who had retired from service prior to 1.1.86, shall not be eligible for the grant of ex-gratia beyond the age of 25 years.

2. Ministry of Railways are requested kindly to take further necessary action in the matter accordingly.
