Sub: Revision of pension in respect of post-1.1.1996 pensioners.

Instructions were issued vide Board's letter of even number dt. 8.2.2000 clarifying that the nount of pension sanctioned to the Railway servants retired on or after 1.1.1996 based on the vised scales of pay should not be reduced if the initially allotted revised scales of pay have replaced by improved scales of pay, and the pay re-fixed downwards. These clarifications in accordance with Rule 90 of Railway Services (Pension) Rules, 1993, which prohibits nward revision of pension except on account of detection of clerical error subsequently. rd's letter dt. 8.2.2000 referred to above does not have a mention about the effect of ward refixation of pay on DCRG and leave encashment. The matter has been considered he Board and the position is clarified as under.

Whereas pension is determined on the average emoluments drawn during the last ten months of service, DCRG and leave encashment are calculated on the basis of emoluments war immediately before retirement. The pay finally refixed on the improved scales of pay is pay actually drawn by the Railway servant and the pay together with dearness allowance emoluments for the purpose of ssible thereon at the time of retirement constitutes culation of DCRG and leave encashment. In view of this, the DCRG and leave encashment alculated otherwise than on the basis of these clarifications would require to be re-calculated accordingly.

Where, on recomputation of DCRG and leave encashment on the basis of the above larification, any amount of over-payments becoming recoverable, the same may be adjusted gainst the payments, if any, due to the retired Railway servants. On the other hand, if no payment is due to the retired Railway servants, but the overpayments already made on account of DCRG and leave encashment is recoverable, the concerned retired railway servants may be instructed, in writing, to refund the excess amount due to Railways within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of communication and if the instructions are not complied with by them, the amount due to the Railways may be recovered in one or more instalments from the dearness relief admissible on pension without any further notice.
