**Sub: Allotment of higher pay scales to Railway Accounts Staff –  
Revision of Pension regarding.**

\*\*\*\*\*

Instructions were issued vide Board's letter No. PC-V/98/1/11/23 dt. 7.3.2003 for grant of higher pay scales to Railway Accounts Staff on notional basis w.e.f. 1.1.1996 and actual payment prospectively from 19.2.2003. Subsequently, instructions on revision of pension of the Accounts staff, who retired during the period 1.1.1996 – 18.2.2003, were also issued vide Board's letter of even number dt. 16.6.2004. The National Federation of Indian Railwaymen has now sought clarification as regards the pay for the pre-19.2.2003 period, to be taken into account for determining the average emoluments in respect of the Accounts Staff covered by the instructions of Board dt. 7.3.2003 and retired on or after 19.2.2003.

2. The matter has been examined in Board's office and it is clarified that in respect of the Accounts staff, who had retired on or after 19.2.2003, average pay for 10 months shall be calculated by taking into account pay as follows:-

- (i) For the period prior to 19.2.2003 during which pay was drawn in the corresponding Vth CPC scales of pay – basic pay notionally refixed in the higher replacement scale of pay, as a special case in relaxation of rules; and
- (ii) For the period from 19.2.2003 till the date of retirement – the pay drawn in the higher replacement scale of pay.

3. The cases of pension sanctioned otherwise than in terms of the position clarified in para 2 above, if any, may be re-opened and revised accordingly.

**विषय : रेल लेखा कर्मचारियों को उच्चतर वेतनमानों का आबंटन - पेंशन में संशोधन करने के संबंध में.**

रेल लेखा कर्मचारियों को 1.1.1996 से कल्पित आधार पर उच्चतर वेतनमान प्रदान करने तथा 19.2.2003 से उत्तरव्यापी प्रभाव से वास्तविक भुगतान करने के लिए बोर्ड के 7.3.2003 के पत्र सं. पी सी-V/98/1/11/23 के तहत अनुदेश जारी किए गए थे। बाद में, उन लेखा कर्मचारियों, जो 1.1.1996 - 18.2.2003 की अवधि के दौरान सेवानिवृत्त हो गए थे, की पेंशन में संशोधन संबंधी अनुदेश भी बोर्ड के 16.6.2004 के समसंख्यक पत्र द्वारा जारी किए गए थे। नेशनल फेडरेशन ऑफ इंडियन रेलवे मैन ने बोर्ड के 7.3.2003 के अनुदेशों द्वारा शासित तथा 19.2.2003 को या उसके बाद सेवानिवृत्त हुए लेखा कर्मचारियों के संबंध में औसत परिलब्धियाँ निर्धारित करने के लिए लेखों में लिए जाने वाले 19.2.2003 से पूर्व की अवधि के लिए वेतन के संबंध में अब स्पष्टीकरण मांगा है।

2. बोर्ड कार्यालय में इस मामले की जांच की गई है और यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि उन लेखा कर्मचारियों के संबंध में, जो 19.2.2003 को अथवा उसके बाद सेवानिवृत्त हो गए थे, 10 महीने के औसत वेतन की गणना निम्नानुसार वेतन को लेखों में लेते हुए की जाएगी :-

- (i) 19.2.2003 से पूर्व की अवधि के लिए जिस अवधि में वेतन तदनुसूची पांचवें केन्द्रीय वेतन आयोग के वेतनमानों में लिया गया था - एक विशेष मामले के तौर पर नियमों में छूट देते हुए, उच्चतर प्रतिस्थापन वेतनमान में कल्पित आधार पर पुनः निर्धारित मूल वेतन; तथा
- (ii) 19.2.2003 से सेवानिवृत्ति की तारीख तक की अवधि के लिए - उच्चतर प्रतिस्थापन वेतनमान में लिया गया वेतन.

3. ऊपर पैरा 2 में स्पष्ट की गई स्थिति के अनुसार अन्यथा स्वीकृत पेंशन के मामले को, यदि हों, पुनः खोले जाएं तथा तदनुसार संशोधित किया जाए।
