Treatment of Dearness Pay as pay for the purpose of advances/final withdrawals under SRPF rules.

In terms of Board's letter No. PC-V/2004/A/DA/1 dated 11.3.2004 Dearness Allowance equal to 50% of the existing basic pay shall be merged with the basic pay and shown distinctly as dearness pay, which would be counted for various purposes including contribution to GPF/SRPF. In the light of these instructions, clarification has been sought from various quarters as to whether the dearness pay would also form part of pay for determining the amount of advances/final withdrawals admissible under the SRPF Rules.

- The matter has been examined in Board's office and it is clarified that sub rule (2) of Rule 922 of Indian Railway Establishment Code, Volume-I (IREC-I) provides for treating dearness pay as part of emoluments or pay under Rules 923 to 925 of IREC, Vol -I. Accordingly, DA equal to 50% of the existing basic pay being treated as dearness pay w.e.f. 1.4.2004 would form part of basic pay for determining various advances/final withdrawals admissible under Rules 923 to 925 of IREC-Vol.I.
