**Sub: Treatment of Dearness Pay as pay for the purpose of
advances/final withdrawals under SRPF rules.**

In terms of Board's letter No. PC-V/2004/A/DA/1 dated 11.3.2004 Dearness Allowance equal to 50% of the existing basic pay shall be merged with the basic pay and shown distinctly as dearness pay, which would be counted for various purposes including contribution to GPF/SRPF. In the light of these instructions, clarification has been sought from various quarters as to whether the dearness pay would also form part of pay for determining the amount of advances/final withdrawals admissible under the SRPF Rules.

2. The matter has been examined in Board's office and it is clarified that sub-rule (2) of Rule 922 of Indian Railway Establishment Code, Volume-I (IREC-I) provides for treating dearness pay as part of emoluments or pay under Rules 923 to 925 of IREC, Vol -I. Accordingly, DA equal to 50% of the existing basic pay being treated as dearness pay w.e.f. 1.4.2004 would form part of basic pay for determining various advances/final withdrawals admissible under Rules 923 to 925 of IREC-Vol.I.

**विषय : राज्य रेल भविष्य निधि नियमों के अंतर्गत अग्रिम/अंतिम निकासी के प्रयोजन के लिए
महंगाई वेतन को वेतन के रूप में माना जाना.**

बोर्ड के 11.3.2004 के पत्र सं. पी सी-V/2004/ए/डीए/1 के अनुसार, मौजूदा मूल वेतन के 50 प्रतिशत के बराबर महंगाई भत्ते का विलय मूल वेतन में किया जाएगा तथा उसे महंगाई वेतन के रूप में अलग से दर्शाया जाएगा, जिसकी गणना सामान्य भविष्यनिधि/राज्य रेल भविष्य निधि में अंशदान सहित विभिन्न प्रयोजनों के लिए भी की जाएगी. इन अनुदेशों को ध्यान में रखते हुए, विभिन्न वर्गों द्वारा यह स्पष्टीकरण मांगा गया है कि क्या राज्य रेल भविष्य निधि नियमों के अंतर्गत स्वीकार्य अग्रिम/अंतिम निकासी की राशि का निर्धारण करने के लिए महंगाई वेतन भी वेतन का भाग माना जाना चाहिए.

2. इस मामले की बोर्ड कार्यालय में जांच की गई है और यह स्पष्ट किया जाता है कि भारतीय रेल स्थापना संहिता, वॉल्यूम-I के नियम 922 के उप नियम (2) के अंतर्गत महंगाई वेतन को, भारतीय रेल स्थापना संहिता, वॉल्यूम-I, के नियम 923 से 925 के अंतर्गत परिलब्धियों या वेतन का भाग माना जाएगा. तदनुसार, 1.4.2004 से मौजूदा मूल वेतन के 50 प्रतिशत के बराबर महंगाई भत्ते को महंगाई वेतन माना जा रहा है और इसे भारतीय रेल स्थापना संहिता, वॉल्यूम I के नियम 923 से 925 के अंतर्गत स्वीकार्य विभिन्न अग्रिमों/अंतिम निकासियों के निर्धारण के लिए मूल वेतन का भाग माना जाएगा.
