**Sub: Grant of provisional family pension in relaxation of  
rules/orders in respect of employees kidnapped by  
insurgents/terrorists in terrorist infected areas – regarding.**

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The instructions regarding grant of provisional family pension to the families of kidnapped Railway employees have been issued vide Board's letter even number dated 18.10.2002. As per these instructions, the cases for sanction of provisional family pension have to be dealt with in terms of Board's letter No.F(E)III/86/PN1/17 dtd.19.9.1986, 27.3.1991 and 21.1.1994, which when applied to the cases of kidnapped employees provide for sanction of provisional family pension to the eligible member of the family after the lapse of a period of one year from the date of lodging a report with the concerned Police Station of the incidence of kidnapping.

2. The issue raised by the staff side in the DC/JCM for grant of immediate financial assistance to the family of such kidnapped employees and to sanction family pension even before expiry of a period of one year from the date of lodging report with the concerned Police Station, has been examined by the Board in consultation with the Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare(DOP&PW). The DOP&PW, in further consultation with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, regretted the proposal of this Ministry for sanction of family pension in such cases before expiry of a period of one year from the date of lodging report with the concerned Police Station, but have conveyed no objection if this Ministry decides to extend the instructions contained in their (DOP&PW's) O.M. dated 29.8.1986, adopted on the Railways vide Board's letter dtd.19.9.1986, referred to in para 1 above, in cases of families of kidnapped Railway employees.

3. In the light of the above, it has now been decided by the Board that the instructions contained in Board's letters dtd.19.9.1986, 27.3.1991 and 21.1.1994 for grant of immediate financial assistance such as the amount of salary due, leave encashment due and the amount of Provident Fund, and for sanction of family pension/retirement gratuity after the lapse of a period of one year from the date of lodging a report with the concerned Police Station, in respect of Railway employees and pensioners who have suddenly disappeared and whose whereabouts are not known, may also be extended to the families of kidnapped



Railway employees subject to observance of the procedures and fulfillment of all the conditions stipulated in Board's letters dated 19.9.1986, 27.3.1991 and 21.1.1994.

विषय - आतंकवाद से प्रभावित क्षेत्रों में उपद्रवियों/आतंकवादियों द्वारा अपहृत कर्मचारियों के संबंध में नियमों/आदेशों में छूट देते हुए अंतिम परिवार पेंशन प्रदान करने के संबंध में.

अपहृत रेल कर्मचारियों के परिवारों को अंतिम परिवार पेंशन प्रदान करने के संबंध में बोर्ड के 18.10.2002 के समसंख्यक पत्र द्वारा अनुदेश जारी किए गए हैं। इन अनुदेशों के अनुसार, अंतिम परिवार पेंशन की मंजूरी के मामलों पर बोर्ड के 19.9.1986, 27.3.1991 तथा 21.1.1994 के पत्र सं. एफ (ई)-III/86/पी एन 1/17 के अनुसार कार्रवाई की जानी है, इन अनुदेशों को अपहृत कर्मचारियों के मामलों में लागू किए जाने पर, इनमें अपहरण की घटना की संबंधित पुलिस स्टेशन में रिपोर्ट दर्ज करने की तारीख से एक वर्ष की अवधि बीत जाने के बाद परिवार के पात्र सदस्य को अंतिम परिवार पेंशन की मंजूर किए जाने की व्यवस्था की गई है।

2. ऐसे अपहृत कर्मचारियों के परिवार को तत्काल वित्तीय सहायता प्रदान करने तथा संबंधित पुलिस स्टेशन में रिपोर्ट दर्ज करने की तारीख से एक वर्ष की अवधि की समाप्ति से पहले भी परिवार पेंशन की मंजूरी देने के लिए डी सी/जे सी एम में कर्मचारी पक्ष द्वारा उठाए गए मुद्दे की पेंशन एवं पेंशनभोगी कल्याण विभाग से परामर्श से बोर्ड द्वारा जांच की गई है। पेंशन एवं पेंशनभोगी कल्याण विभाग ने आगे वित्त मंत्रालय, व्यय विभाग से परामर्श करके संबंधित पुलिस स्टेशन में रिपोर्ट दर्ज करने की तारीख से एक वर्ष की अवधि की समाप्ति से पूर्व ऐसे मामलों में परिवार पेंशन की मंजूरी के लिए इस मंत्रालय के प्रस्ताव पर असहमति जताई है परंतु उन्होंने अपहृत रेल कर्मचारियों के परिवारों के मामलों में यदि यह मंत्रालय पेंशन एवं पेंशनभोगी कल्याण विभाग के 29.8.1986 में अंतर्विष्ट अनुदेशों, जिसे उपर्युक्त पैरा 1 में उल्लिखित बोर्ड के 19.9.1986 के पत्र के द्वारा रेलों पर अपनाया गया है, को विस्तार देने का विनिश्चय करता हैं तो उन्हें इस पर कोई आपत्ति नहीं है।

Subject:- Grant of provisional family pension in relaxation of rules in respect of employees kidnapped by insurgents/terrorists in terrorist infected areas – reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the Ministry of Railways O.M. No.F(E)III/2001/PN1/28 dated 13.02.2004 on the above subject and to say that the matter has been examined again in this Department in consultation with the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure.

2. The Ministry of Railways' proposal for delegation of powers to that Ministry for payment of provisional family pension and gratuity within one year of lodging of FIR, in cases of employees kidnapped by insurgents/terrorists, has not been agreed to in this Department

3. There is no objection in this Department if the Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) decide to extend the instructions contained in this Department's O.M. No.1/17/86-P&PW dated 29.08.1986 in cases of families of kidnapped Government servants. The O.M. may, however, be adopted in totality with conditions prescribed therein for payment of family pension, gratuity etc.
