Sub: Travelling Allowance Rules - Implementation
of the recommendations of the Vth Central
Pay Commission - Journeys on Transfer -
Settlement of arrear claims.


Consequent to revision of entitlements to TA on transfer providing for a Composite Transfer Grant w.e.f. 1.10.1997, vide Board's letter referred to above, arrears on account of revised entitlements are payable in terms of para 4 thereof.

2. A question has been raised as to how the Daily Allowance (for the journeys performed by the officer and his/her family) and the Road Mileage Allowance (for the journeys between residence and the Railway Stations at Old and New Stations) on transfer, already drawn by the transferees, shall be adjusted, while settling the arrears claims preferred by the employee. It is hereby clarified that since these allowances shall no longer be admissible w.e.f. 1.10.97, the payments already made on this account shall be deducted from their revised entitlements in terms of Board's letter No. F(E)I/98/AL-28/10(A) dt. 1.5.1998, before payment of arrears.

3. Accordingly, the concerned employees may be allowed the arrears only after deducting the Daily Allowance and Road Mileage Allowance already drawn by them. Compliance of these orders may please be ensured while settling the arrears claims preferred by the Railway employees in terms of para 4 of Board's letter dt. 1.5.98 referred to above.
