Sub: Payment of TA/DA to Retired Railway  
servants for journeys undertaken by them  
for attending departmental enquiry as  
defence assistants.


As per the extant rules, retired Railway employees  
attending DAR enquiry as assistants of the delinquent  
employees are entitled to TA/DA as per the pay drawn/post  
held by them immediately prior to their retirement.

2. The question has been raised by AIRF as to how the  
rates of Daily Allowance/Mileage Allowance as revised  
vide Board's letter No. F(E)I/98/AL-28/9 dated 24.4.98,  
consequent to revision of pay scales on the basis of the  
recommendations of the Vth Central Pay Commission, will  
be payable to the retired employees performing the journeys  
as defence assistants.

3. The matter has been examined in consultation with the  
Ministry of Finance. It is hereby clarified that for the  
purpose of Daily Allowance/Mileage Allowance for journeys  
for attending departmental enquiries as Defence Assistants  
to delinquent employees, performed on or after 1.10.97,  
by employees who retired before 1.1.96, the pay will be  
reckoned by taking into account the basic pay drawn by  
them at the time of their retirement plus Dearness Allowanc  
as admissible on 1.1.96 (e.g. 148% of basic pay for  
employees drawing pay upto Rs.3500/-) plus I & II  
instalments of Interim Relief. Arrears, if payable, in  
terms of these orders may also please be paid.
