
Sub: Travelling Allowance Rule - Payment of Composite
Transfer Grant to Railway Employees for settlement
after retirement.

One of the Railways have raised a doubt whether Composite Transfer Grant could be paid to the Railway employees at the time of payment of settlement dues on the date following the date of superannuation in order to avoid hardship to the employees settling at far off places.

The matter has been examined. It has been decided that the claim for full settlement of Composite Transfer Grant may be entertained and paid alongwith the settlement dues, if the retiring Railway employee has already transported his personal effects finally and has submitted the necessary documentary proof therefor. Other terms and conditions for grant of this allowance remain unchanged.




