**Sub: Amendment to Para-648 and Para-651 of IRMM 2000 - Delegation of powers to General Managers – Reg.**

Based on the recommendations of Sreedharan Committee, Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) have decided to amend Para-648 and Para-651 of IRMM 2000, as circulated vide Board's letter of even number dated 24.09.2013, in the following manner:-

**Para-648 ( 1 &2) of IRMM 2000 – Medical Reimbursement**

Authority	Powers delegated
General Manager of Zones/Construction Unit / PUs, DG-NAIR, DG-RDSO and CAO of PUs	The financial powers mentioned in the existing Para stands substituted as under:- “To sanction medical reimbursement upto Rs.10 lakhs (Ten Lakhs) for treatment taken in non-recognized private hospitals, and without any limit for Government Hospitals including Autonomous Body Hospitals* in emergency. These powers shall not be delegated further down by GMs and shall be exercised with concurrence of FA&CAO.”

\* Autonomous Body Hospitals are those Hospitals, which are fully funded by Government Funds but given autonomy for administrative purposes, like AIIMS, NIMS (Hyderabad).


**Para-651 (note below the para) of IRMM 2000 – Medical Advance**

Authority	Powers delegated
General Manager of Zones/Construction Unit / PUs, DG-NAIR, DG-RDSO and CAO of PUs	The financial powers mentioned in the existing note below the Para stands substituted as under:- “To sanction referral of patients in emergency to private non-recognized hospitals with sanction of advance upto Rs.10 lakhs (Ten Lakhs) in each case. These powers shall not be delegated further down by GMs and shall be exercised with concurrence of FA&CAO.”

2. All other provisions under Para-648 & Para-651 of IRMM 2000 and also the norms/ procedures contained in Board's letter Nos.2005/H/6-4/Policy-II dated 31.01.2007, 16.04.2007 (except Para-6.3), 22.06.2010 and in Board's letter No.2011/H/6-4/Policy-I dated 24.09.2013, shall remain unchanged.

3. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate in the Ministry of Railways and has the approval of the President.


