Sub: Medical examination of candidates proposed for appointment in Railway through Open Market Recruitment conducted by Railway Recruitment Board.


Ref: This office letter of even number dated 09.11.2015.

Attention is invited to Board's letter cited under reference wherein certain direction was conveyed for medical examination of RRB candidates.

Arising out of a reference, the issue has been examined afresh and it has been decided, in suppression of Board's letter cited under reference, that the zones should follow the under-mentioned procedure for medical examination of RRB candidates before declaration of final results:-

1. Number of candidates to be deputed for medical examination to any divisional hospital each day will be decided by the PCMDs concerned in consultation with RRBs depending upon the infrastructure available in the divisional hospital as well as availability of doctor(s) for conducting medical examination.
2. The candidates should have proper authority as laid down in Annexure 5 of 515 & 516 of ^{TAMM} 2000.

Sub:- Medical examination of candidates proposed for appointment in Railway through Open Market Recruitment conducted by Railway Recruitment Board.


A proposal for medical examination of candidates proposed for appointment in Railways is under consideration in the Ministry of Railways. Such medical examination of candidates is proposed before declaration of final results by Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs). Details of decision taken will be conveyed to Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) by the Establishment Directorate in the Board's office.


As regards, medical examination of such candidates, Railway Recruitment Boards (RRBs) will be sending the candidates for medical examination duly complying the following stipulations:

- I. Not more than 20 candidates should be deputed for medical examination to any Divisional/Zonal Hospital each day.
- II. The candidates should have proper authority as laid down in Annexure 5 of 515 & 516 of 2000.

It is desired that medical examination of such candidates, when deputed by RRBs with proper authorisation should be ensured within the laid down time frame.
