Sub: Joint procedure order for implementation of Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri-Jan Arogya Yojana in the identified Railway hospitals.

Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) and National Health Agency have entered into an MOU in order to implement Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri-Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) in identified Railway hospitals (copy of the identified hospitals enclosed).

To implement AB PM-JAY a Joint Procedure Order as given below is to be followed by the concerned Railways in identified Railway Hospitals coming under their jurisdiction.

S. No.	Actionable points	Persons responsible
1.	Preparation of list of identified hospitals in every zone.	As per the list of 93 identified Hospitals enclosed herewith.
2.	Nomination of medical co-coordinator in each identified hospitals.	PCMD of the Railways.
3.	Appointment of Non medical coordinator in each hospital on outsourcing basis.	CMS, Sr. DFM and Sr. DPO should co-ordinate to initiate the proposal and to be sanctioned by DRM /ADRM.
4.	Arrangement of requisite hardware and internet along with necessary accessories and stationery.	DRM/ADRM in co-ordination with concerned Sr. DSTE.
5.	Indoor beds and facilities as per specialty available should be identified.	Same has been mentioned in the list of identified Hospitals enclosed herewith.
6.	Uploading the facilities and resources as available in NHA website for the beneficiaries of (AB PM-JAY) scheme.	Medical coordinator of the concerned hospital.
7.	Treatment to be started only after receiving online approval for the same from (AB PM-JAY) website. The identified hospital will be providing the medical facility under the scheme to the identified beneficiaries by utilizing the existing resources including the manpower of the hospital. No new infrastructure/manpower will be sanctioned for this purpose.	Medical coordinator of the concerned hospital.
8.	Provision of medicines and arrangement of the procurement of the same for the concerned hospital.	PCMD of the Railways along with the CMS and Medical coordinator of the particular hospital concerned.






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9	Provision of the in-house investigation for the admitted patients.	PCMD of the Railways along with the CMS and Medical coordinator of the particular hospital concerned.
10	Raising of the bills for expenditure incurred for indoor treatment (as per package).	Medical coordinator (Railway Doctor) in co-ordination with non medical coordinator. Concurrence of bill by associate finance and approval of DRM/ADRM concerned.
11	Expenses made for treatment of Ayushman Bharat patient and money received for treatment to be booked in separate head.	The following accounts heads are introduced in F-II for separate account of receipts: expenditure under AB PM-JAY. Expenditure In the Head J-270. Expenses under Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri- Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM JAY) In the Head 271 for Cost of Medicines. In Head 272 for cost of implant, appliances. In Head 273 for other expenses including investigations, diet charges etc. Receipts In the Head Z-656 receipts on account of AB PM-JAY.. CMS and Sr. DFM to ensure for the same at field level. Accounts may be reconciled annually.
12	The responsibility of ensuring smooth rendering of the facility to the eligible beneficiary in the identified Railway hospital.	DRM/ADRM in co-ordination with CMS and medical coordinator of the concerned hospital.
