

Sub:-Common Memorandum of Understanding for empancment of private hospitals.

Ref:-Board's letter no. 2016/H-1/11/69/Hospital Recognition dated 23.12.2016.

In pursuance to the directions of Central Vigilance Commission to incorporate provision related to limitation of time period for submitting the claims by the referral hospitals as per Limitation Act 1980, the competent authority has decided to incorporate a time limit of six months under clause 12 (Processing of Claims/Bills by the BPA) of the common MoU cited under reference for preferring of claims by Railway empanelled hospitals for medical expenses for treating Railway beneficiaries from the date of completion of treatment/date of discharge. Hence, no claims of empanelled hospitals after a period of six months from the date of completion of treatment/date of discharge of Railway beneficiary shall be accepted by the Railway authority.

Accordingly, All Zonal Railways/Production Units are advised to incorporate the changes made in Clause 12 of MoU already entered/to be entered into with the empanelled hospitals.
