
Sub:- Extension of medical facility to wards.

Ref:- ICR's letter No. PB/GL/12A/Policy dated 14.05.2015.

The issued has been examined in consultation with Finance Directorate in the Board's office.


Attention in this context is drawn to Para 612 (A)(2) of IRMM, 2000 wherein it has been stipulated that the retired employee or spouse of the deceased employee can join medical facility under RELHS. Further, Board's letter No. 2006/H/28/1/RELHS dated 18.05.2007 stipulates that medical facilities to the dependent family members of Railway employees who die in harness, will continue to be given to them till filling up of forms of settlement dues. The stipulations made further provide that in case they opt to join the RELHS scheme, the RELHS identity card may be issued in their favour after their having deposited the amount of RELHS contribution in cash or by authorising the administration to deduct the same from their final statement dues.

In view of above, provision has already been made to grant medical facilities to the dependents and family members of Railway employees who die in harness, till the time of filling up of forms of statement dues. In case, they opt to join the RELHS Scheme, the RELHS identity card may be issued in their favour after their having deposited the amount of RELHS contribution in cash or by authorising the administration to deduct the same from their final statement dues.


