Sub: Polio vaccination campaign on 18.01.2015 and 22.02.2015.

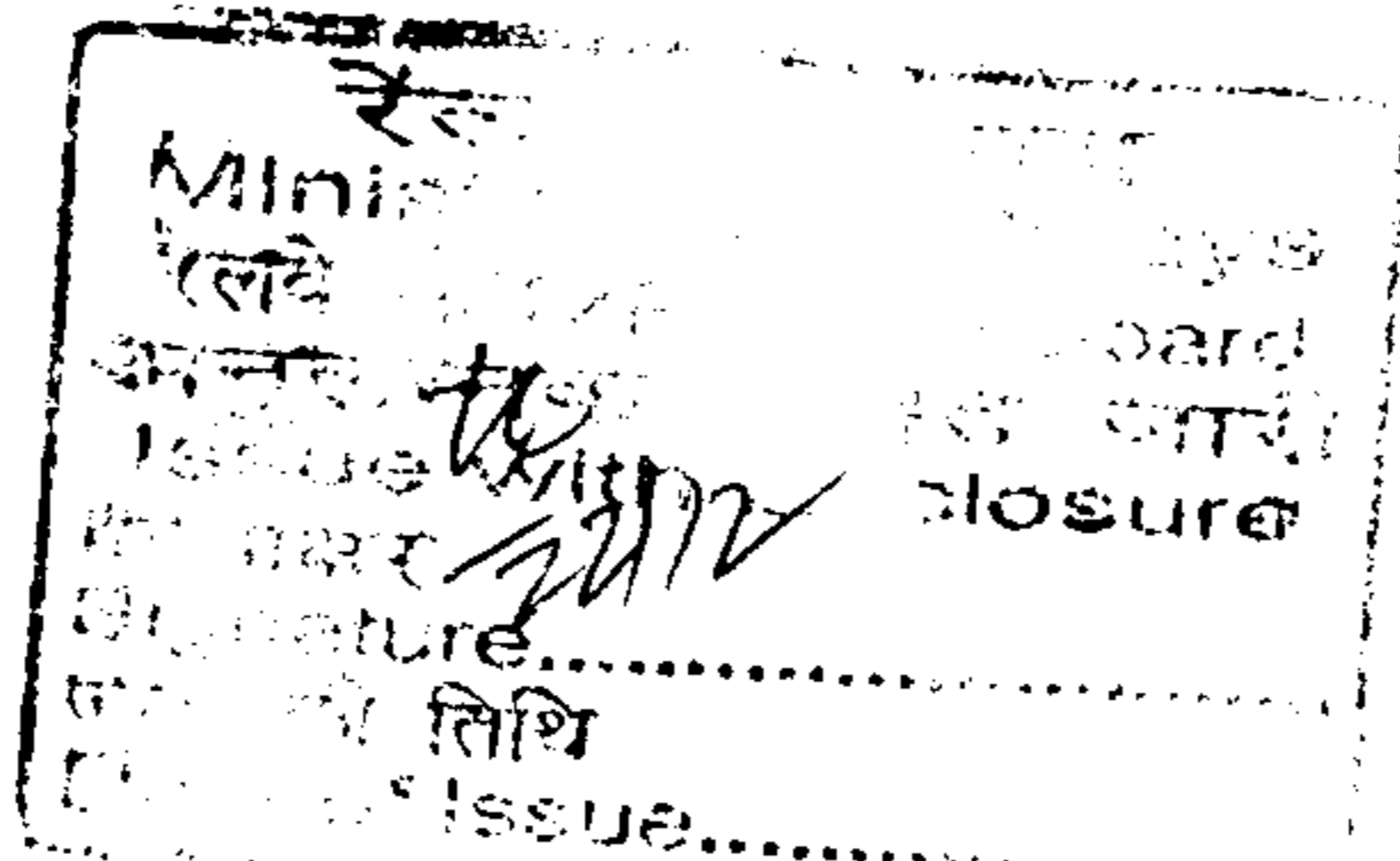

Attached herewith please find the copy of letter under reference. It is a matter of pride that India has achieved Polio free certificate from WHO on 27 March 2014.

However the vigil has to be kept up as wild Polio Virus is still under circulation in some parts of the world. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has decided to conduct two nation-wide polio vaccination campaigns, first on 18 January and second on 22 February, 2015. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has sought the following help from Ministry of Railway.

- (a) Set up booths at all major railway stations across the country, from where trains originate or terminate;
- (b) As in the past, allow vaccination teams to vaccinate children in moving trains;
- (c) Set up polio vaccination booths in all railway colonies and to ensure that children of all railway staff receive the polio vaccine;
- (d) Allow the state government to set up booths at all railway stations for transit passengers having children of below 5 years of age and for immunizing children in the trains;
- (e) Allow the railway stations and railway coaches to be used for display of posters and other IEC materials; and
- (f) Advise all railway men to motivate their neighbours to get polio vaccine for their children.

It is in National interest to do everything possible to make this endeavour a success. All concerned working under you in the Zone/PU may kindly be advised to extend all possible help in this programm.
