Sub:-Delegation of powers related to empanelling of private hospitals/stand alone centres for referral of dialysis cases.

At present, cases requiring dialysis are being referred to hospitals which are already on the panel. However, in places, where there are no recognized hospitals for dialysis, the patients are facing difficulty in getting hemo-dialysis on regular basis on a cashless method.

The matter has been under review and it is now decided to empower the General Managers to empanel private hospitals/stand alone centres providing dialysis, as per CGHS rates or lower rates for referral of dialysis cases only. In recognizing such hospitals/stand alone centres, due diligence should be done by a committee of doctors, as is done in the case of empanelling private hospitals.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
