Sub:- Charges levied on outsiders for treatment in Railway Hospitals.

After preventive checks Vigilance Department has pointed out that in some of the railway hospitals the outsiders are being treated/operated without charging any money. This is causing loss to the railway exchequer. In some cases extra money was charged, this too is a serious misconduct.

It is hereby reiterated once again that for treatment/operation of any outsiders in the railway hospitals charges as already laid down in Railway Board's letter no. 2012/H-1/2/9 dated 25.09.2013 have to be levied and deposited in Railway revenue.

Even if railway hospital wishes to collaborate with any State/Central Health Agency/Department for implementation of any National Programme, approval of competent authority should be taken for treating outsiders in the railway hospitals. There should be a clear concurrence of finance for the charges to be levied/waived off for the treatment of outsider's in the Railway Hospital under this collaborative effort.
