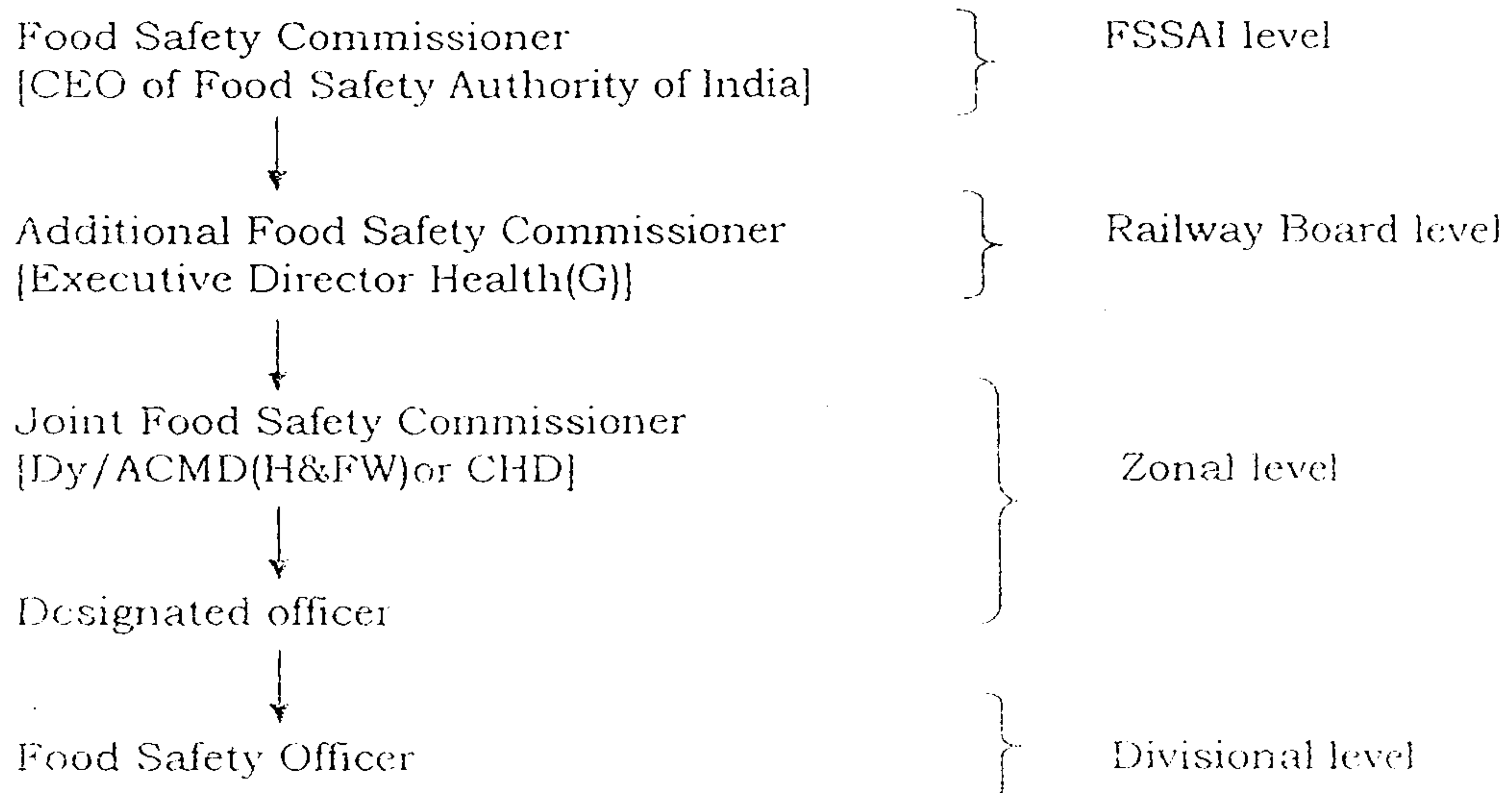
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In continuation of this office letter referred above it has been decided by Board (MS) to redesignate a few posts from the pool & H&MI as FSO so that there is one FSO in every division for implementation of Food Safety and Standards Act 2006 and Food Safety and Standards Rules 2011 effectively over Indian Railways.

This is to be an internal arrangement to meet statutory provisions under Food Safety and Standards Act, and does not tantamount to creation of posts.

The new FSO is to be nominated from within the existing cadre of Health & Malaria Inspectors on the basis of seniority cum suitability.

The hierarchy to implement FSSA within Railway shall be as follows:-



The FSO shall be placed under administrative control of the CMS.

Necessary action in this regard may be taken under intimation to the Board.
