Sub: Quarterly inspection of ARMVs—submission of inspection reports to the Chief Medical Directors of the zone—reg.

Ref: Para 1.6.13 contained in C&AG's report on Railways for the year ending March 2014.

Comptroller General of India in Para 1.6.13 of their report on Railways for the year 2013-14 have highlighted the deficiencies observed in maintenance of equipments in Accident Relief Medical Vans. It has also been pointed out by the Audit that though quarterly inspections of ARMVs have been carried out, in certain cases the Inspection Reports have not been submitted to the respective Chief Medical Directors. The Audit has also contended that the equipments & medicines etc. in the ARMVs are not being replaced periodically. In this context it is noted from the IRMM that the provisions contained in IRMM do not make specific provision for submission of inspection reports to the Chief Medical Directors. Similarly the contention of Audit that equipments & medicines etc. provided in ARMVs should be replaced periodically is also well taken.


After careful consideration in the matter, it has been decided that the zonal railways should ensure submission of the Inspection Reports to the CMDs in all the zones. Further, medicines in the ARMVs should be replaced periodically and all the medical equipments be repaired/replaced periodically so that recurrences of deficiencies pointed out by Audit in the Audit Para do not recur.
