Sub: Mentioning of Matters of Urgent Public Importance-Special Mention raised by Dr. Ashok Kumar Mittal, MP.

During the 266th Session of the Parliament in Rajya Sabha on 04.12.2024 Dr. Ashok Kumar Mittal, Hon'ble Member of Parliament (MP) has made a special mention of increasing contempt cases in the country as matter of urgent public importance.
