Sub: Committee report on requirement of manpower for en-route watering of the trains.

Ref: i. Railway Board letter no. 96/M(C)/141/77 dated 19.06.2024. ii. SCR letter no. M.13//C&W/ Watering/217 dated 27.06.2024.

Vide letter under reference above, a committee of CRSE/Chg./SCR and CRSE/Chg./SR had been constituted to submit a report on requirement of manpower for enroute watering of the trains.

The committee submitted its report vide reference ii above. In reference to the report submitted by the committee following items has been approved:

- a. A minimum of 10 minutes stoppage time is recommended for filling of entire rake. There should be designated watering stations for each train and watering points should be included in the Working Time Table.
- Manpower deployment is recommended as minimum 1 for every two coaches including two trains watering on side-by-side lines.
- c. If two trains are required to be watered simultaneously (non-adjacent lines), then an additional gang is required and vice-versa.
- d. There is a need of walkie-talkie, minimum of 2 no's for the filling group (front part of the rake and rear part of the rake) and 1 for the pump operator to have immediate coordination.
- e. Staff should have gum boots, high visibility reflective poncho/ raincoat with hood for rainy environments, Rechargeable LED headlamps of at least 400 lumens for use in evening/night shifts.

The above has the approval of the Board (MTRS).
