BPC is issued after carrying out various safety checks as per laid down procedure and instructions. Proper and 100% functioning of WSP devices, which is one of the many safety check, is also governed under one such maintenance instruction and the same needs to be followed by the maintenance depots. Compliance to all such safety instructions can not be recorded on BPC.

Accordingly, there is no adequate justification for recording working of WSP device and earthing return circuit on the BPC, however, the same should be recorded in the concerned maintenance register and made a mandatory pre-requisite for issue of BPC by the TXR.
