

Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation CPR


PUMP

Make the person flat on ground and compress the lower part of sternum (Chest Bone) by both hands so that it goes down at least 2 inch. This should be 30 times, followed by breath. Compression should be 100 times / minute.



RESPIRATORY

Tilt the head back and lift the chin. Pinch both the nostrils and blow after covering the mouth with yours so that chest moves at least by 1 inch. Give 2 breaths and then again pump.



CONTINUE WITH 30 PUMPS AND 2 BREATHS.
