Sub: Functioning of Controlled Discharge Toilet System (CDTS) in coaches

It is seen that the Controlled Discharge Toilet System (CDTS) provided in coaches is not functional in many of the trains. The Zonal Railways should ensure that the CDTS in their coaches is made functional at an early date, for which the system of maintenance followed by BCT depot of Western Railway can be studied. This issue was also discussed during the CMEs conference held at Nainital on 5th & 6th May 2017.

The action plan and cut off date for making the CDTS functional may be advised to Board at the earliest.
