With a view to improve upon the objectivity as well as contract administration, in as far as contracts for coach cleaning are concerned, a standard test check/inspection protocol for different service contracts viz. mechanized cleaning of rakes and depot premises, Clean Train Stations and OBHS etc. as enclosed may henceforth be uniformly followed by the Railways. The enclosed test check protocol only defines the minimum frequency of inspections/test checks and may not be taken as restrictive.
