BRIEF HISTORY OF ALAMBAGH WORKSHOP

Carriage & Wagon workshop, Alambagh was established in 1865 at Lucknow under Oudh & Rohilkhand Railway (O&RR). In 1952, Alambagh workshop became a part of Northern Railway. Over last 144 years this Workshop has witnessed a lot of changes in its product mix. POH of goods stock was totally stopped Feb'1995 onwards. Presently the main activity of this workshop is POH of coaching stock concentrating on ICF design Self-generating stock. With the increase in EOG stock, AMVW has recently started POH of ICF type EOG AC coaches. AMVW has taken up PU painting of coaches making NR the only Railway to undertake PU painting universally. The shop also manufactures NMG coaches, ART coaches, Camp coaches, Rest Vans. This workshop is ISO-9001 certified. A work for modernization of workshop has been recently sanctioned by Railway Board at estimated cost of Rs. 77.47 Crores.
