BRIEF HISTORY OF AMRITSAR WORKSHOP

ASR Workshop was setup by the Punjab Government in 1901 to meet maintenance requirements of Head Works Machinery of Punjab Public works Department (Irrigation Branch). After passing through the hands of the Defence Department and Punjab Government it was finally taken over by the Railways on 1st June 1956. At present Amritsar workshop is manufacturing BOXN HL & BVZI wagons along with catering to the requirement of wheels of RCF & divisions. ASRW undertakes other manufacturing activities such as bogie frame manufacture, Wagon sidewalls, End-beam assembly for WDP locos, head stock for coaches.

ASRW is the second Railway unit in Northern Railway undergoing composite certification of ISO 9001, ISO 14001 and OHSAS 18001. ASRW has developed a lighting system for BVZI wagons without batteries.
