3. The programs under working professionals categories are delivered in hybrid mode and sessions will be conducted in offline and online mode to best facilitate the working professionals. Online lectures will be offered in evenings or weekends for the convenience of working professional. The courses will be covered in 2 semesters each year. There will be two mandatory in-campus modules (each of two weeks) in a year at GSV Campus, Vadodara i.e. one module in each semester. During on-campus modules, officials need to attend lectures and discussion sessions with instructors, participate in offline evaluations, and experience the GSV environment in person. Besides, the officials will be required to be physically present for the Semester End Examinations. Officials can do the thesis project under the joint supervision of GSV faculty and a mentor from their sponsoring organization. Further, the officials can work on a real life problem at their respective railway as a part of a graduation thesis project. ### A. M.Tech Programs-

i. B.Tech/BE with at least 60% marks or at least 6.5/10 Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)(50% Marks or at least 5.5/10 CGPA/CPI for the reserved category candidates)

- ii. Candidates shall be a full-time employee with minimum two years of work experience and sponsored by the railway.
- iii. Reservation as per the Govt. of India Norms.
- iv. Maximum age of candidates shall be 50 years at the time of applying for the program.
- v. The officers should be Group A (officers in the pay level 10 and above or equivalent in PSUs).
- vi. Officers should be clear from vigilance angle and should have requisite APAR grading (at least very Good in the last five years).

### B. MBA Programs-

- i. Bachelor's degree in any discipline with Mathematics or Statistics as one of the subjects, with at least 60% marks or at least 6.5/10 Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)(50% Marks or at least 5.5/10 CGPA/CPI for the reserved category candidates)
- ii. Candidates shall be a full-time employee with minimum two years of work experience and sponsored by the railway.
- iii. Reservation as per Govt. of India norms.
- iv. Maximum age of candidates shall be 50 years at the time of applying for the program.
- v. The officers should be Group A (officers in the pay level 10 and above or equivalent in PSUs).
- vi. Officers should be clear from vigilance angle and should have requisite APAR grading (at least very Good in the last five years).

# C. Ph. D in Engineering-

- i. Applicants with a Master's degree in Engineering/Science, namely M. Tech, M.E., M. Sc. (Engineering/Science) or MS at least 60% marks or at least 6.5/10 Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). Applicants are required to have at least 605 marks or 6.5/10 CPI or CGPA in Bachelor's degree. (50% Marks or at least 5.5/10 CGPA/CPI for the reserved category candidates).
- ii. Applicants with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering with B.Tech/B.E or B. Sc. (Engineering) 4-year degree with at least 80% marks or at least 8.5/10 CPI or CGPA.
- iii. Candidates shall be a full-time employee with minimum two years of work experience and sponsored by the railway.
- iv. Reservation as per Govt. of India norms.
- v. Maximum age of candidates shall be 50 years at the time of applying for the program.
- vi. The officers should be Group A (officers in the pay level 10 and above or equivalent in PSUs).
- vii. Officers should be clear from vigilance angle and should have requisite APAR grading (at least very Good in the last five years).

### D. Ph. D in Management-

Master's degree in Management/Humanities/Social Sciences/Engineering or allied areas with at least 60% marks or at least 6.5/10 Cumulative Performance Index (CPI) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). Such students are required to have at least 605 marks or 6.5/10 CPI or CGPA in Bachelor's degree. (50% Marks or at least 5.5/10 CGPA/CPI for the reserved category candidates).
- ii. Applicants with a Bachelor's degree in Engineering with B.Tech/B.E or B. Sc. (Engineering) 4-year degree with at least 80% marks or at least 8.5/10 CPI or CGPA.
- iii. Candidates shall be a full-time employee with minimum two years of work experience and sponsored by the railway.
- iv. Reservation as per Govt. of India norms.

- v. Maximum age of candidates shall be 50 years at the time of applying for the program.
- vi. The officers should be Group A (officers in the pay level 10 and above or equivalent in PSUs).
- vii. Officers should be clear from vigilance angle and should have requisite APAR grading (at least very Good in the last five years).

- ii. The selection process involves two stages i.e. GSV Entrance Test and Viva-Voce.
- iii. The initial screening will be done based on the Entrance Test and the candidates scoring minimum 50% marks in the Entrance Test will be shortlisted for Viva-Voce.
- iv. The merit list will be prepared based on the composite scores of the Entrance Test (50% weightage) and Viva-Voce (50% weightage).

The programs under working professional categories are delivered in hybrid mode and sessions will be conducted in off-line and online mode to best facilitate the working professional (students). In general, online lectures will be offered on evenings or weekends for the convenience of working professionals.

5) What is Campus Immersion for Programs under the Working Professional Category? There will be two mandatory in-campus modules (each of two weeks) in a year at GSV campus, Vadodara i.e. one module in each Semester. During these on-campus modules, students attend lectures and discussion sessions with instructors, participate in offline evaluations, and experience the GSV environment in person. The schedule of the campus immersion will be communicated well in time after the admissions. Besides, the students will be required to be physically present for the Semester End Examinations. Students can do the thesis project under the joint supervision of GSV faculty and a mentor from their sponsoring organization. The student can work on a real life problem at their respective organization as a part of a graduation thesis project. The program will be offered in a hybrid mode, which would include synchronous teaching in online/ offline mode ensuring an intensive interaction with the faculty and amongst the students.

# 13) What are the timings of classes for MBA/M.Tech./Ph.D (Working Professional) programs?

- Online classes will be scheduled on Friday (6.30 to 8.30 pm), Saturday & Sunday (9.00 am to 1.30 pm and 3.00 to 7.30 pm).
- Offline classes will be conducted for 15 days of campus immersion during the mid of the semester.

# 14) Which score of XAT/MAT/CAT/CUET-PG/ IMU-CET will be valid for the admission in MBA (Regular) programs?

The latest score of XAT/MAT/CAT/CUET-PG/ IMU-CET at the time of application will be valid as per the deadline (last date to apply).

# 15) Will there be sponsorship/financial support for Working Professionals?

No. Working Professionals are not eligible for any scholarship/ financial support at the University.

# 16) Will University provide campus placement to the candidates securing admission under MBA/M.Tech./Ph.D (Working Professional) programs?

No. Working Professionals are not eligible for campus placement drives at the University.

### 17) Is reservation applicable for scholarship/financial aid?

No. The scholarship/ financial aid are extended based on Merit cum Means basis.

### 18) Are programs approved by UGC or AICTE?

In India, the academic programs at Central Universities are governed by the Central Universities Act, 2009. This Act, along with the statutes and ordinances framed under it, defines the university's purpose, powers, and governance. The programs at the Central Universities are approved by the professional bodies such as Academic Council and Executive Council.

# 19) Will physical study material be provided to Working Professional Category candidates?

The soft copy of the reading material will be provided by the faculty. Students need to purchase the prescribed text book at their end.

### 20) Will there be internships/projects for working professionals?

Yes. As per the curriculum displayed at <a href="https://gsv.ac.in/program-curriculums/">https://gsv.ac.in/program-curriculums/</a> - 4 to 6 weeks of internships in MBA/M.Tech. (Working Professionals) program and graduation thesis project spreaded over two semesters is part of the curriculum.



21) What is the duration for Ph.D. program and course work requirements? Minimum duration of Ph.D program is 4 years.

Students need to undertake 16 to 20 credits of coursework (equivalent to 6 to 7 courses).

# 22) Can a candidate apply for more than one program?

Yes. A candidate has a choice to apply for multiple programs by paying the application fees and submitting separate applications for each program. Based on the merit list and selection, admission will be offered in one program.
