The above recommendation has been accepted by Railway  
Board.

2. In this context the Railway Administrations are directed that all  
the training centres under the Railways control may be advised that  
all trainees should be carefully observed during the course of training  
with a view to assess whether they have attributes to become future  
trainers. Such assessment should be made available to the authority  
concerned who will keep the same in employees Personal Record  
and at the time of selection/posting of trainers this should be taken  
note of.
