Railways have sought clarification on instructions issued vide Board's letter No.E(MPP)86/13/2, dated 28.3.89, whether instructors/Trainers who have been repatriated to their original cadre on completion of five years, if after sometime, again volunteer for the posts of Instructors, can be allowed to appear in the selection of Instructors against a fresh notification.

The matter has been considered and it has been decided that the Zonal Railways/Production Units, etc. may screen the repatriated instructors, who volunteer against fresh notification only after a reasonable gap of atleast one year.

This also disposes off N.F. Rly.'s letter No.E/254/1/52/2 (M) Pt.II, dated 30.3.94.
