Consequent to the revised status of RDSO as a Zonal Railway, it has been decided that subject to the outcome of the Writ Petition No. 3866/98 pending before the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi the under mentioned categories of staff in RDSO will be allotted revised pay scales as given below on prospective basis from the date of such revision in the status of RDSO:-

2. **Pay Fixation:-** The concerned staff will have their pay fixed in accordance with FR-23 {1317-IREC-Vol.II (1987 Edition)} and FR-22(I)(a)(2) {Amended Rule -1313 (I)(a)(ii) circulated as ACS No. 14 to IREC Vol. II 1987 Edition vide Board's letter No. F(E)II/89/FR-1/1 dated 12.12.91} read with Audit Instructions (1) below FR-22 with the normal option for pay fixation under extant instructions. In other words, the pay of the incumbent would be fixed at the stage of the time scale which is equal to his pay in respect of the old post held by him on regular basis, or, if there is no such stage, the stage next above his pay in respect of the old post held by him on regular basis. Provided further that in case where pay fixed at the same stage, the next increment will be drawn on the date of increment in the pre revised V CPC scale and in cases where pay is fixed at the higher stage, he shall get his next increment on completion of the period when an increment is earned in the revised time scale. When pay is drawn at the maximum of the old scale and there is an equal stage in the revised scale Audit Instructions (1) below FR 22 will have to be taken care of while determining next increment in the revised scale.

3. RDSO may please examine the feasibility of better productivity in the M&C Directorate.
