Sub : Introduction of Additional pay scales – recommendations of V CPC

In pursuance of Vth Central Pay Commission's recommendations, the issue of introduction of new scales for certain categories as recommended by the Commission has been under consideration of the Board. Introduction of the new pay scales in accordance with the recommendations of the pay scales for these categories of staff was to be effected on functional considerations. The matter has been considered and the Ministry of Railways, with the approval of the President have decided that two existing posts of Fieldmen in the Northern Railway in the existing scale of Rs.3050-4590 should be upgraded to the scale of Rs.4000-6000 and re-designated as Horticulture Mistry Grade II. Similarly, one post of Fieldman in DLW in the existing scale of Rs.3050-4590 should be upgraded to the scale of Rs.4000-6000 and re-designated as Horticulture Mistry Grade II.

1.1 Date of effect

Staff who are placed in the higher grade as a result of implementation of these orders will draw pay in the higher grade with effect from the date of issue of these orders.

1.2 Classification and filling up of the vacancies

The posts of Horticulture Mistry Grade II will be filled up on the basis of a suitable Trade Test.

1.3 Pay Fixation

Staff selected and posted against the higher posts as a result of introduction of new scale will have their pay fixed under Rule 1313(R-II)(FR-22-I(a)1) with the usual option for pay fixation as per extant instructions.


1.4 Minimum years of service for promotion to the new grade

The normal minimum eligibility conditions of 2 years service in the minimum lower grade will apply.

1.5 Provision of Reservation

The existing instructions with regard to reservation of SC/ST will continue to apply while filling up posts in the new grade.

विषय:- अतिरिक्त वेतनमान लागू करना-पांचवे केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों.

पांचवें केंद्रीय वेतन आयोग की सिफारिशों के अनुसरण में, आयोग द्वारा यथा संस्तुत कतिपय कोटियों के लिए नए वेतनमान लागू करने से संबंधित मुद्दा बोर्ड के विचाराधीन रहा है. इन कोटियों के कर्मचारियों के लिए वेतनमानों की सिफारिशों के अनुसार नए वेतनमान इन कोटियों के प्रयोजनमूलक प्रतिफल के आधार पर लागू किए जाने थे. मामले पर विचार किया गया है और रेल मंत्रालय ने राष्ट्रपति जी के अनुमोदन से विनिश्चय किया है कि उत्तर रेलवे में 3050-4590 ₹० के मौजूदा वेतनमान में फील्ड मैन के दो मौजूदा पदों को 4000-6000 ₹० के वेतनमान में अपग्रेड किया जाए और इन्हें बागवानी मिस्त्री ग्रेड-11 के रूप में पुनः पदनामित किया जाए. इसी तरह, डीजल रेल इंजन कारखाना में 3050-4590 ₹० के वेतनमान में फील्डमैन के एक मौजूदा पद को 4000-6000 ₹० के वेतनमान में अपग्रेड किया जाए और इसे बागवानी मिस्त्री ग्रेड-11 के रूप में पुनः पदनामित किया जाए.

1.1 प्रभावी होने की तारीख

इन आदेशों के कार्यान्वयन के परिणामस्वरूप उच्चतर ग्रेड में आने वाले कर्मचारी, इन आदेशों के जारी होने की तारीख से उच्चतर ग्रेड में अपना वेतन प्राप्त करेंगे.

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1.2 विधियों का वर्गीकरण तथा कृते मरना

बागवनी मिस्त्री ग्रेड-11 के पदों को उपयुक्त ट्रेड परीक्षा के आधार पर मरा जाएगा.

1.3 केतन निर्धारण

नए केतनमान लागू करने के परिणामस्वरूप उच्चतर पदों पर चुने गए तथा तैनात किए गए कर्मचारियों का केतन मौजूदा अनुदेशों के अनुसार केतन निर्धारण के सामान्य विवरण के साथ नियम 1313 अर-11 (एफ.अर-22 -1 प 1) के अंतर्गत निर्धारित किया जाएगा.

1.4 नए ग्रेड में पदोन्नति के लिए सेवा के न्यूनतम वर्ष

न्यूनतम निम्न ग्रेड में 2 वर्षों की सेवा की सामान्य न्यूनतम पात्रता शर्त लागू होगी.


1.5 आरक्षण की व्यवस्था


